Criteria for Application

2. Topics must address therapeutic/diagnostic methods, procedures, or theory. Submissions focusing on ethics may receive special consideration as two hours of ethics training are required by the KY SLP Board.
3. Workshops must be open to all KSHA members and submitted for announcement on the CE Events tab on the KSHA website *prior to* being held. If this is not possible, please state reasons why and they will be considered case by case.
4. Grant recipient will submit appropriate paperwork in a timely manner for ASHA CEU Approval.
5. Grant recipient agrees to acknowledge KSHA's support on all pre- and post-publications.
